

## Discipline Policy

In order to have a successful, safe, and positive classroom environment for all students, we have established the following discipline policy. Please review and discuss the classroom rules and consequences with your child.

### Classroom Rules

1. Listen carefully and follow directions.
2. Follow all school rules.
3. Be patient and respect others. Be kind with your words and actions.
4. Raise a quiet hand to talk and never interrupt the speaker.
5. Work and play safely.

To help students monitor and make adjustments to their behavior, we will be using a card system. The system starts new each day. If a student chooses not to follow the classroom rules he/she removes a strip from their pocket and earns a negative consequence. The color code is as follows:

- Green - Wonderful behavior!
- Yellow- Warning, an improvement in behavior is needed.
- Orange - Second warning. The student spends a recess in time out and brings home a note to be signed and returned the next day.
- Red - Third warning. All recesses spent in time out. A referral is sent to the office. Referral must be signed and returned the next day.

Students who choose to follow the classroom rules will earn positive consequences which include verbal praise, calls or notes home, special privileges or activities, prizes, etc.
